JOY OF SERVICE: THE CSR INITIATIVE

Selection for CUMI's Centre for Skill Development (CCSD)

CUMI's Centre for Skill Development (CCSD) of Chennai based Murugappa Group works closely with 3 institutions including NOCPL, to select 120 deserving candidates from low income families and impart adequate skills that enhances their employability. They offer a 3-year course in Electrical, Machine Assistant, Fitter and Turner. After the course is completed they are employed by the Murugappa Group.

In addition to providing free accommodation, food, skill training and a stipend, the candidates are also provided with qualitative training to enhance their soft skills.



This year 195 out of 695 candidates passed the exam from all over Tamil Nadu. After the final round of personal interview, 40 candidates have been shortlisted. These 40 students shall be joining the course from October 2019.


